Ennio Mastrobattista, 66, of Syracuse passed away on Thursday. He was born in Fondi, Italy, moved to Syracuse in 1966, and attended Henninger High School. He was employed at Wegmans in Dewitt where he worked for 33 years as a baker, as well as Nino's Italian Bakery. Ennio was a generous, hard-working man, with a great sense of humor. He enjoyed spending time with his beloved family around the dinner table.

Ennio is predeceased by his daughter, Gina; parents, Donato and Carmela; and brothers Enzo and Bruno.
