Louis A. Vecchio, 93, of Clay, NY made his journey to see The Lord, his family, and friends in Heaven on Friday morning, June 5, 2020. Lou was born Americo Andreo Vecchio on May 28, 1927. He was raised in the House of Providence orphanage after his mother passed away and his father was unable to care for all of their children by himself. Lou was a Seabee in the U.S. Navy Construction Battalion at age 18 until the end of World War II. He began Vecchio Heating and Air Conditioning in 1955 and incorporated into Salina Heating & A/C Corp. in 1962 with his business partner Aldo Bonacchi. He was a bowler and an avid golfer. He was also on the board for the Syracuse Heating Contractors Association and the Syracuse Heating, A/C, Sheet Metal Contractors Association. He retired in 1992 and was an inspector for the City of Syracuse until age 89.

In his later years, Lou loved spending time with his family and the love of his life. He was so proud and felt very blessed to have lived his life as long as he did. He turned 93 just nine days prior. We are fortunate to have had him in our lives this long.

Lou is predeceased by his first wife, Stella; his second wife, Althena; his mother, Anna; his father, Frank; stepmother, Maria; brothers, Mario, Joseph, Sam, James, and Frank; sisters, Nancy Arrigo, and Catherine Sorenson.

He is survived by his sweetheart, Jeanne Peterson; his loving daughter, Rose Marie (Corling) Stevens; granddaughter, Cristina Wagner; grandson, Alexander Smith; great-grandsons, Fernando and Dominic; great-granddaughters, Gabriela and Paityn; loving stepdaughter, Kathleen; and his brother, Anthony.
