



## William "Billy" Crupi

June 20, 1941 - January 30, 2022

William "Billy" Crupi, 80, of Liverpool, passed away at his home on January 30, 2022. Born in Syracuse, he was the son of the late Sarah (D'Agostino) and Anthony Crupi. Billy put in 40 years at Bristol Laboratories, although for some time his children were under the impression that he was a secret agent.

He was a member of the Italian American Athletic Club. A scratch golfer, Billy's hobbies included pretending to dislike Yogi and lamenting the Yankees' inability to advance runners in scoring position.

Billy is survived by his wife, Linda Crupi; his two children, Lisa (Will) Mayers of Cicero and Anthony Crupi of Brooklyn; four grandchildren, John Mayers of Denver, Nicholas (Jane) Mayers of Syracuse; Joe Mayers of Cicero and Diana Mayers of Bridgeport; brother, Robert (Jackie) Crupi; great-grandson, Gianni, of Bridgeport, as well as several aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins.
